The Gold Rush is an annual outdoor event for ALL Cub Scouts and parents to enjoy together. It will be held at Camp John J. Barnhardt on the 1,000 acre William C. Cannon Scout Reservation in New London, NC. All packs are encouraged to host various games and activities for Cub Scouts to enjoy. Participants do not have to camp to be involved with the Gold Rush. Registration by pack is a must. (deadline for all fees: Wednesday, October 14)

NO LATE REGISTRATION

What each pack (or den) should bring to the Gold Rush:

- 1 action game for every den or 6 boys (see "How To" book for suggestions)
- 1 bag of candy for every 3 boys (for recognition at games)
- 1 bucket of gold-painted gravel for every den or 6 boys (gold will be placed in activity field as you arrive to set up your game)

All packs attending with 10 or more boys are required to have an activity field event

(There is no electricity or water source in the game field)

Cub Leader Registration Procedures

Because 1200+ people participate, pack registration is a **MUST** and is required for an orderly check-in. No individual registration will be accepted. A complete pack roster must be in the **council office by Oct. 14.**

Packs are invited to camp for the weekend (arrival **no** earlier than 3:30 pm Friday). All food and equipment resources are the responsibility of the packs that choose to camp.

Please follow these procedures exactly. The office will only have two days to prepare identification bracelets, parking and lunch passes, etc. All items will be distributed to Cubmasters in each district on Sunday afternoon, October 18. We look forward to a great time and appreciate your helpfulness! **For your safety, closed-toed shoes only! NO PETS!**

Remember: each pack may designate 1 vehicle only for transporting gear to the campsite (1 vehicle x 10 people per pack, example - a 40 person pack may have 4 vehicles) up until 7:00 pm Friday night (9:00am Saturday) and after that time ALL equipment (including trailer) must be towed by official camp vehicle. *Parking permits will be mailed. Equipment trailers may be left in the campsite, but ALL other vehicles must be returned to parking lot. We must have your cooperation in this matter.

The Gold Rush is an exceptional and fun event for All Cub Scouts and their parents. Cubs find gold nuggets as admission for the games. If a Cub has more than five gold nuggets at any one time, he could be apprehended by the sheriff. Appropriate fines are the loss of all but three gold nuggets and/or by singing a song.
