

Eagle Application Process

Becoming an Eagle Scout can be an exciting and memorable time in a Scouts life. In the Central North Carolina Council, we would like to make the process as easy and trouble free as we can. To get a Scout's Eagle Application verified, the Scoutmaster has four different options on how you are able to submit it.

- The preferred option would be to email the application to Kyle Camp, Council Program Director (Kyle.Camp@scouting.org). This option would take about five business days to complete.
- The second option would be to mail to the Council Service Center (PO Box 250, Albemarle, NC 28002). Using this option would take about five business days to complete as well.
- The third option would be to walk the Eagle Application into the Council Service Center. This option would as well take five business days to complete.
- The final option would be to give the Eagle Application to your local District Executive who would bring the application to the Council Service Center. The executives would bring the application in the next time they are at the office. This option would take ten business days to complete.

After verification, the application is sent back to the Scoutmaster. Only after this, should the Board of Review be scheduled. After the Board of Review, you will have to submit the application with all the signatures. Please allow seven to nine weeks for the application to process and to receive the Scout's Eagle packet. This would allow two weeks to process at the Council Service Center, four to six weeks at the National Office and one week for delivery back at the Council Service Center.

Upon receipt at the Council Service center, your District Executive will contact the Scoutmaster to arrange delivery of the award packet. If you would like to expedite the process, you may pay \$65 fee and will take four to five weeks.
