

Central NC Council Cub Scout Day Camp Code of Conduct

The following rules apply to all scouts and volunteers:

- Show respect to others.
- No bad or rude language.
- Keep your hands to yourself. No fighting, pushing or hitting.
- Every camper is expected to abide by the customs, policies, and ideals of the Central NC Council, B.S.A.
- Use the buddy system at all times.
- Cub scouts must stay with your den at all times.
- Check in and out with Den Leaders when leaving the area with your buddy.
- No knives regardless of earning your Whittling Chip.
- No smoking.
- All medication must be given to the Camp Medical Staff for dispersal.
- All campers must be checked out and picked up by a parent or authorized pick up person.
- All late arrivals must check-in at the Command Post.

Discipline Procedures

- Minor incidents will be handled by the Den Leader.
- Repetitive incidents or those incidents that the Den Leader feels uncomfortable handling will be handled by the Camp Director / Program Director
- The Camp Director does have the authority to dismiss a scout from camp and to further ban him from returning.
- Any volunteers not abiding by the Code of Conduct will be asked to fix their actions, and if it happens again, they will be asked to leave.

The sole purpose of the Code of Conduct is to provide a safe and fun environment for the participants and its volunteers.
