Facilities & Activities

Camp Barnhardt is over 1,000 acres of beautiful, rolling wooded hills beside Badin Lake and is one of the premier Scout camps in the Southeast. Camp Barnhardt features fun-filled activities for Cub Scouts, siblings and parents. Activities during your weekend will include: ARCHERY, PERSONAL FITNESS, FIELD GAMES, BB GUNS, FIRE BUILDING and an exciting EVENING CAMPFIRE.

Camp Barnhardt has wall tents on platforms with cots. If you do not wish to sleep in these tents, you are welcome to bring your own. Please carpool and pack light as vehicles will stay in the parking lot.

Registration/Sessions

Check with your Pack leaders on the session they are attending and mark your 1st, 2nd & 3rd choices on this form. Sessions are filled on a first come, first served basis. If your 1st choice is filled, we will notify you with the session we have placed you in. Please do not show up for a session you are not booked for as there will be no on-site registration due to space limitations. Register early, as camp will only hold 400 people per session. Every effort will be made to keep Packs camping in the same area. No matter which session you choose, it is a fun packed 18 hours at camp. The Registration form is located on the bottom of this flyer.

Check-In

If you choose a Friday session, check in between 5:00pm—7:00pm, depart at noon on Saturday. If you choose a Saturday session, check in between 1:30pm—2:30pm, depart Sunday morning by 9:00am. For the Saturday session, YOU MAY NOT arrive before 1:30pm, as we have to get the parking lot cleared from the previous session. Camp rules are: no use of tobacco, no alcohol, no pets, no firearms, no video games or television and no fireworks. Scout attending must be a registered Cub Scout.

What to Bring

Sleeping bag, pillow, flashlight, toothbrush, rain gear, jacket (evenings can get cool) and hat. Place sleeping items in a heavy duty garbage bag for the Scout to carry or in a waterproof duffle bag or backpack. The walk to your campsite could be 1/4 mile or more. DRESS ACCORDING TO THE WEATHER! Event will be held Rain or Shine.

Meals

Supper is on your own. It should be kept simple, or bring precooked. Breakfast is the only meal that will be provided.

Fees

\$20.00 per person, non refundable. Fee includes breakfast, patch for all participants, activities and program materials. Siblings ages 6 and up may participate with paid fee. Siblings under 6 may attend but will not be able to participate in activities. If you want a Cub/Parent weekend t-shirt, you must pre-order the shirt. All sizes are \$15.00. Payment is required with your registration.
