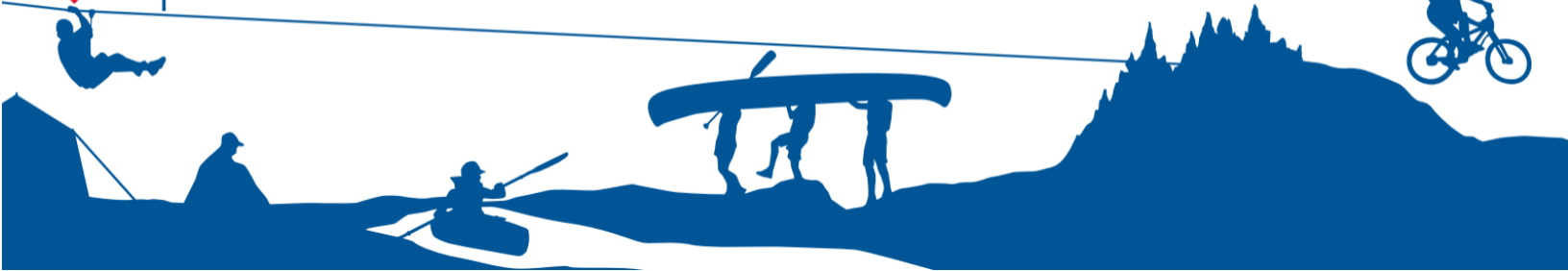


Camp John J. Barnhardt May 10 – May 12, 2019 Leader's Guide

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GENERAL INFORMATION:

- Location:** Camp John J. Barnhardt **Date:** May 10-12, 2019
- Registration:** Pre-registration is required and must be completed using the council online registration system. Deadline for registration and updates to existing registrations is May 5, 2019.
- Fees:** \$30 per Scout and \$10 per Adult Leader
- Payment:** All registrations must be paid online. You may pay by credit card or enter the account information from your check with no additional fees. Make sure you receive a confirmation and receipt in e-mail to ensure you completed the process. Print your ticket and bring it with you to check-in. If you need special assistance, please contact your district executive.
- Check In:** 5:00 pm - 8:00 pm on Friday, May 10th and 7:00 am – 8:00 am Saturday, May 11th . Early Check-in is **not** allowed on Friday – You will not be able to access campsite prior to 5pm.
- Camping:** Camping will be on your own. Troops will need to fill out a camp permit and send it to Kyle Camp at Kyle.Camp@scouting.org
- Parking:** Only vehicle towing trailers will be allowed in camp for up to 30 minutes to disconnect trailer and return to parking lot.
- Garbage:** Each troop is to have its own plastic bags for garbage. Each troop is responsible for taking its garbage out of camp or to the dumpsters at the Dining Hall. Campsites will be inspected at the end of the weekend.
- Water:** The water may be off in campsites, so each troop should bring a water container that can be filled at either the bathhouse
- Bathroom:** The only bathrooms that will be open will be the ones in the campsites and the bath house at Campsite #4 and front side of bath house at ranges..
- Health Forms:** Each Troop is required to have [Annual Health and Medical Records](#) (Part A & B) for every participant (Scouts and Adults). These forms should be in the possession of the registered leader and available for inspection at anytime.
- Meals:** Lunch on Saturday will be provided. All other meals are to be provided by the troops. In order to be served meals, you must register.
- Merit Badges:** Scouts may not complete all merit badge requirements. Some may require long term projects, specific site visits, etc....

Camporee Rules:

- All Scouts and Leaders will live in accordance to the Scout Oath and Scout Law.
- Guide to Safe Scouting and Youth Protection Policies are in effect at all times.
- All vehicles must be left in the parking area.
- No fires will be left unattended at any time.
- Campsites will be assigned by Kyle Camp, Program Director. His contact information is below. It is a first come, first serve basis. If you have special needs to be considered during campsite assignments, please let him know ahead of time.
- All Troops are to observe "lights out" promptly at 10:30 pm. All activities are to stop until sunrise the following morning. Scouts are to be in their campsite and are to remain QUIET.
- Scouts are to follow their scheduled class rotation.
