The Central NC Council will be offering a virtual BALOO training for any Cub Scout leader who is interested. The trainings will consist of seven dates which are outlined in the dates above and all being done virtually. The first six dates will cover three sessions per day with the overnight component being done on July 10th. Participants must attend every session to complete their BALOO training. There is also an online component that must be done prior to the start on June 30th.

Who Should Attend: Any adult involved in Cub Scouting with a desire to plan and carry out an entry level outdoor experience for their Pack. This is the first step in the BSA outdoor training program. Each Cub Scout Pack overnight event must be under the direction of a BALOO trained adult. Additionally, this course includes the training that all Webelos Den Leaders need to be able to plan & conduct (and survive) a Webelos Den overnight campout.
